



BEFORE YOU START


- **Log in** to your SaveTheProof.com account, or **create one** if you don't have one yet.
- Go to the “WhatsApp to PDF” option in the menu on the left side of the screen.
- From the mobile phone you will use to export the chat, save the “SaveTheProof” WhatsApp number to your contacts: **+34 613 44 66 29**.
- Click on the “Generate code to start export” button.




The code has been successfully validated. You can now export the chat:

- 1 Access the chat you want to export from WhatsApp on your mobile.
- 2 If you have iOS, click on the contact's name. If you have Android, click on the menu with the 3 vertical dots.
- 3 Select the "Export chat" option (if you have exchanged audios or videos, you will be able to choose whether to export them or not).
- 4 Select the WhatsApp icon and then choose the SaveTheProof contact (+34613446629).
- 5 Send the file and continue the process from your computer.


2 SELECT DATES

Once our system has processed the chat, you will be able to select the date range of the messages you want to export and your WhatsApp username using the dropdown menu “Who are you?”.




